GENERAL GUIDELINES

Pictures should be original, not prints, mounted, and framed (where appropriate) using 2 mm picture glass. Non-reflective glass and plastics of any kind are not acceptable. Canvas paintings should have the sides of the canvas painted neatly. Work that is not presented to a high standard, will not be selected.

You will be informed via email or phone if your work has not been hung due to limited space etc., and a committee member will take it 'home' for you to collect later.

All pictures should be fitted with D rings and picture cord 1/3 of the way down. There is no size limit, but the number of pictures accepted will be dependent on space available. This is a 'commercial' exhibition which we hope will be successful for our members. Please help by telling your friends and family.

All work must be clearly labelled on the back of the picture with the Artist's name, telephone and contact details, title of work, medium and price. All work is exhibited at artist's own risk.

There is a fee of £3.00 per work up to 3 pictures. 4th picture 'free'.

20% commission/donation on sales will be given to the church. Please factor this into your price.

This is not a 'normal' exhibition venue. We will display pictures on chairs alongside the walls of the church and they will be tied onto the chair (or easel). If you have a robust easel or table easel, please bring it with you (with your name and phone number on the reverse).
